Dr. McGee couldn't be with us but wanted us to know the messages to the workers in Haiti have been very important. We can CONTINUE to walk and send messages. She is very grateful and will be with us next month to give us a complete update.

Background information: The violence in Haiti has become unbearable. Dr. McGee has been involved in humanitarian efforts for many years with Father Wismick and counselors who provide help to orphanages in the area. When they leave their homes to serve these children, their lives are in danger. Dr. McGee has asked us to walk the labyrinth with the intention provided and then send a note via the link provided. The counselors feel invisible, and we can show them they are in our hearts and seen. Feel free to walk more than once and send more than one message.
